We're doing a Rapid Fire Rifle Match on June 9th. It'll be any repeating rifle with "sustained" fire, 40 shots in 5 minutes @ 100 yards on SR-1 targets. (like 4 rapid fires in a row) Shoot from any standard position you like best- Prone, sitting, kneeling, or offhand. Cost \$10. First relay starts at 9 am.

You'll need your rifle & 40 rounds in clips/mags. Any repeating rifle you have enough ammo for is fine – 22's, AR's, Garand, Carbine, '03, SMLE, Mauser, Nagant, etc., slings & scopes OK, no sighters. Bayonets & accoutrements optional. Vic has .30-'06 CMP ammo available at a good price for use in competitions at the LSA Gunshop for members.

Though it's a fun shoot, we'd like to Remember the Brave Men who carried these rifles while Fighting for Freedom. Instead of prizes, we would like to donate the proceeds to the Johnny Ro Veterans Memorial on Mechanic St. <http://johnnyroveteransmemorialpark.org/>
